# "HARRISBURG"

The Tugboat "Harrisburg" operated in New York harbor from 1900 until 1963. We have reproduced this 100' Pennsylvania Railroad Tugboat from the original shipbuilder's plans in a 1/32nd scale (3/8":1') museum grade model which is radio-controlled with both live steam or electric power as standard equipment. Only 150 limited edition models will be produced with optional 1/32nd scale 100' Pennsy rail car float which will accommodate up to four 1/32nd scale rail cars. We feel this is the finest limited edition ship model ever offered and is the first in a series of ship models to be produced by Marketing Corporation of America.




