TIPS

2. USE WAX ON YOUR MODEL RIGGIN LINES TO ELIMINATE THAT FUZZI LOOK.

3. ON THE BRIDGE WINDOWS CLEAR PLASTIC, BECOMES OPAQUE WHEN SPRAYED WITH "DULL COTE"... DO A TEST STRIP FIRST--TO SEE HOW YOU LIKE IT.
